



CMVP[®] Training and Exam

EfficienTerra Services (ETaS) is pleased to announce a **CMVP[®] training & exam** to be held on **November 11-13, 2014**, at **Singapore**. The training is offered in collaboration with the International Institute for Energy Training (IJET) as an EVO[®] International Training partner.

This session will be held in **English**.

OVERVIEW

The Efficiency Valuation Organization is an international non-profit organization that maintains the International Performance Measurement and Verification Protocol (IPMVP[®]).

The IPMVP is the leading international standard in M&V protocols, has been translated into 15 languages and is used in more than 100 countries. It is now typically cited as the basis for federal, state and utility M&V protocols.

Training and Certification Programs

EVO[®] provides training for M&V professionals in order to raise the standards in M&V. Using its international expertise, the organization develops special workshops and training programs tailored to the needs of specific regions.

EVO offers worldwide its L3 M&V training for the Certified Measurement & Verification Professional (CMVP[®]) exam administered by Association of Energy Engineers (AEE). The right to use the CMVP[®] title is granted to those who demonstrate proficiency in the M&V field by passing a 4-hour written exam and meet the required academic and practical qualifications. EVO's training is offered as preparation for the exam, and as a review of basic principles for experts.

Who should take this training?

- **Building or industry owners who wish to measure the energy savings generated by their projects.**
- **Building or industry owners who wish to partner with ESCOs to implement Energy Efficiency (EE) projects.**
- **Employees responsible for EE program evaluation and operation.**
- **Engineering firms or professional firms specialized in energy efficiency.**
- **ESCO employees required to conduct energy audits, prepare Measurement and Verification (M&V) plans or monitor project savings.**

CMVP Exam and certification

EVO Instructors will administer the four-hour CMVP[®] exam following the training. Those seeking the CMVP[®] designation must meet the following requirements (in addition to passing the exam):

- › Have 4-year degree from an accredited university or college in science, engineering, architecture, business, law, finance, or related field plus 3 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification; OR,
- › Have Registered Professional Engineer (PE) or Registered Architect (RA) plus 3 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification; OR,
- › Have 4-year non-technical degree from an accredited college or university in a field not specified above plus 5 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification; OR,
- › Have 2-year technical degree plus 5 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification; OR,
- › Have 10 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification; OR,
- › Have Current Status of Certified Energy Manager[®] (CEM[®]).

Applicants must register for the CMVP[®] exam by submitting an application to EVO[®] in advance. If all eligibility requirements are met and a passing exam score is achieved, AEE as certification body in conjunction with EVO[®] will grant the CMVP certification. Those who do not have this qualification at the time of the exam and who pass the exam will receive the title of CMVP-IT (in training). If they gain the necessary qualification within 6-years period, they will be able to apply for a full CMVP title free of charge.

There is a training fee of S\$3,700 including lunches and CMVP[®] exam fee.
